Summer Institutes in Discrete Mathematics for K-8 teachers

The Leadership Program in Discrete Mathematics will feature two two-week residential programs at Rutgers University, New Brunswick NJ, during June 28 to July 9 and during July 12 to July 23, and three two-week commuter programs at Scottsdale AZ (June 3-18), at Rutgers (June 28 to July 14), and in Rhode Island (August 2-17).

Participants will be expected to attend follow-up sessions during the school year and a one-week follow-up institute during the summer of 2000. Graduate credit will be available. Teams of teachers in schools or districts are welcome to apply. Funding by the National Science Foundation provides for all costs of the institutes and a stipend of \$600 for the two-week program. Participants will be expected to assume leadership roles in bringing discrete mathematics to their classrooms and schools, and in introducing their colleagues to these topics.
