WORKSHOPS IN YOUR DISTRICT

**WHAT?**

The Leadership Program in Discrete Mathematics will sponsor one or more full-day workshops in your school or district covering contemporary topics in discrete mathematics and offering ways of introducing these concepts into the classroom and into the curriculum.

**WHO?**

Teachers at all levels should be encouraged to participate in the workshops, since many of the concepts can be introduced to and discussed with students at all levels. Teachers will leave the workshop with complete in-service packages which can be used both by workshop participants and, with their assistance, by other teachers in the district.

**WHEN?**

Workshops will be scheduled during the academic year on an individual basis at the request of the participating district. Workshops are also available for scheduling during the summer. Every effort will be made to accommodate dates requested by interested districts.

**BY WHOM?**

The workshops will be conducted by experienced teachers who have participated in the summer institutes of the Leadership Program in Discrete Mathematics at Rutgers University and in a seven-day training program on preparing and presenting such workshops.

**COST?**

Funding from the National Science Foundation will pay for all administrative costs of the discrete mathematics workshops. The district will be expected to pay only direct costs -- expenses and honoraria for the workshop leaders and instructional materials for the participants.

**WHERE?**

Workshop leaders live in or near the following states: AZ, CA, CO, DC, DE, CT, DE, FL, GA, KY, MA, ME, MD, NH, NJ, NM, NY, NV, OH, OR, PA, RI, TN, WA, UT, VA, VT, WV. For workshops in other states, there will be additional travel expenses.
